



North West Training Hub GP Fellowship

NHS England's General Practice Fellowship scheme is designed to support newly qualified GPs to gain experience within a supportive environment. The programme will help practices and PCNs to recruit and retain GPs by offering attractive roles that lead to long term employment in practice.

The North West Training Hub is seeking expressions of interest from newly qualified GP's (started their career within the last 12 months) to participate in the scheme. The Fellowship is a structured, supportive programme for GPs to ensure they have a high quality first experience in General Practice. Fellows will be employed within general practice although they may work across a Primary Care Network (PCN).

Fellows will be funded for one session per week and have access to a package of support for 2 years, including:

- A High quality induction into their STP, Primary Care Network and GP Practice
- Locality based peer support group which may involve action learning sets and RCGP First Five or Next Generation GP Programme
- Leadership development opportunities to enable Fellows to make real improvements in their practice and Primary Care Network
- Peer mentorship from an experienced GP
- Experiences and shadowing opportunities available to support the development of your portfolio career
