



North West Training Hubs General Practice Fellowship for Nurses

NHS England's General Practice Fellowship scheme is designed to support newly qualified nurses to gain experience within a supportive environment in general practice. The programme will help practices and PCNs to recruit and retain nurses by offering attractive roles that lead to long term employment in primary care.

The North West Training Hub is seeking expressions of interest from newly qualified nurses to participate in the scheme. The Fellowship is a structured, supportive programme for nurses to ensure they have a high quality first experience in General Practice. Fellows will be employed within general practice, although they may work across a Primary Care Network (PCN).

Fellows will be funded for one session per week and have access to a package of support for 2 years, including:

- A High quality induction into their STP, Primary Care Network and Practice
- Supported transition as a newly qualified nurse into Primary Care.
- Supportive networks built around the individual - Assigned to a GPN supervisor
- Regular GPN supervision and coaching sessions with a qualified coach
- Access to Peer support and Action Learning Sets
- Personal Development Plan in place
- Leadership development opportunities to enable Fellows to make real improvements in their practice and Primary Care Network
- A Portfoliocareer - Opportunities for experience and integrated working

(There are no clinical skills taught on this programme)

In joining the programme participants will benefit from a ready-made supportive network built around them.
