

# HEENW Post-CCT Fellowship

**The Fellowship:** Health Education England has offered a number of fellowships that practices can apply to host. They offer 1-2 sessions a week of funded time for education and a bursary of £5000 for educational costs. If a practice is successful in bidding to host a fellow, they can appoint as a salaried or partnership post to a GP within 5 years or receiving their CCT. This year's fellowships will start in April 2021. HEE also runs a **Higher Professional Education (HPE) programme** which is available to all GPs in the first 5 years – including locums as well as those in salaried posts and is based around virtual half day sessions over a range of days - sessions are recorded.

HEE also runs the **Professional Education and Development (PED)** which is an intensive programme over 2 years which is accredited at MSc level by the University of Central Lancashire (UCLAN). This is appropriate for GPs in a salaried or partnership post. The accreditation by UCLAN can link with Educational Supervisor academic accreditation towards a postgraduate Diploma or Masters.
