First Contact Practitioner/ Advanced Clinical Practitioner Ambassador Role

Cheshire & Merseyside Physician Associate (PA) Preceptorship Programme

We are pleased to announce that we will be running the 5th cohort of the Cheshire and Merseyside Primary Care Physician Associate (PA) Preceptorship Programme. This offer is available to both newly qualified PAs or PAs transitioning from another area (i.e. moving from an Acute Trust) and working in primary care in Cheshire and Merseyside. The start date for **Cohort 5** is on the **15th November 2023**.

HEE are in the process of releasing the required application forms so that practices can claim for the £5000 funding for having a PA on the programme. The HEE £5,000 preceptorship funding is for PCNs to liaise with the PA practices. Upon successful applications, practices are to complete the application form to ensure the funding can be provided. We will be in touch once those application forms are available.

In the meantime, for a PA apply for a place please complete the <u>linked</u> form no later than 13th November 2023. Applications after this date will not be accepted if all spaces have been filled. We will keep them on a reserve list should there be a 6th cohort in the future.






